

## Bluebird Sighting Form

Use this form to report your sightings of banded Western Bluebirds in the Mid-Willamette Valley.

Every banded bird has 1 aluminum band with imprinted numbers issued by the federal bird banding laboratory. In addition, a bird may have 1–3 colored plastic bands. For your sighting to be reportable, you must see at least one colored band, or you must be able to read all 9 numbers on the aluminum band.
